Bryan and Carolyn Kepner both natives to Lancaster, moved away, as many young adults do, only to return to Lancaster and start their family. Wanting to be more involved in the renewal of Lancaster City, Bryan and Carolyn chose to make their home here, as well as purchase the building at 114 North Prince Street which now houses Artisans Gallery and POUR - Craft Food and Drinks. **POUR** is an upscale casual bar and restaurant serving craft food and drinks in the heart of Lancaster's Gallery Row, set in a sleek and comfortable interior. The cuisine combines the simple and sublime with fresh, seasonal flavors and top quality ingredients from the region's finest sources. To complement the food, the wine, beer, and cocktail lists deliver an exciting variety that changes with the seasons, giving regulars and newcomers something new to look forward to when they arrive.

Looking for a new challenge, Bryan turned his sights to the ever burgeoning growth in microbreweries. In 1870, Joseph Wacker bought the Eagle Brewery, which had been established in 1853 and stood at the corner of Water and West Walnut Streets in Lancaster City. Thus, began what would eventually become one of the four biggest breweries in Lancaster County. In 2014, Wacker Brewing Company was brought back to life by Bryan Kepner, the great grandson of one of the original brewery's workers. Bryan and Carolyn are committed to providing the same high-quality product and service the Wacker name symbolized!
