We have a private party room comfortable for 20 participants. We now offer canvas painting every Friday night from 6-9pm. We welcome bringing your own food and drink. Both studios are walk-in thus no appointments are necessary.

- The pottery selection is 400-500 pieces from functional to figurine to holiday themed
- There are ~150 colors including both standard colors to specialty glazes
- Pieces are ready a week later
- There is no painting time limit and we hold your piece if you cannot finish in one sitting

- You can come in anytime with no previous experience and make bracelet, necklace or earrings
- We offer many classes and with personalized scheduling
